DOCUMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPLICATION TO DOCTORAL STUDIES

Only complete applications will be processed

- Information sheet duly completed.
- Motivation letter (one page minimum).
- Curriculum vitae (CV).
- Photocopy of passport and visa for foreign students residing in France for a minimum period of 1 year (mandatory to allow the University to verify that this is the correct procedure)
- Grades obtained during your last 3 years of graduate studies and program of courses attended by students graduated from a university abroad. Official academic transcripts must be provided for each semester of each year. If you do not have a transcript (examples: internships, breaks,...), you must enclose a justification..
- Photocopy of diplomas. For students with foreign degrees, the translation must be certified by a consular officer.
- Copy of your personal works (internship reports, professional experience, employment contracts, etc...) and letters of recommendation from your previous teachers, university tutors or people who supervised you during an internship (at least two).
- A letter of recommendation from the foreseen supervisor or host laboratory.
- A proof of funding for the PhD project.

Do not insert originals, but copies (the files remain the Administration's property even if the application is not accepted). No document will be given or sent back to the applicant. The SPI doctoral school may ask the candidate for additional information or documents.
